

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF LIVINGSTON COUNTY LAND BANK CORPORATION TO SIGN A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH NEW YORK STATE HOMES AND COMMUNITY RENEWAL: 2022-2023 LAND BANK INITIATIVE ROUND 1

WHEREAS the Livingston County Land Bank Corporation (the "Corporation") is a notfor-profit corporation duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2022 the Corporation submitted an application to New York State Homes and Community Renewal (HCR) for \$100,000.00 in grant funding from Round 1 of the 2022-2023 Land Bank Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation was notified on September 22, 2022 by HCR that is has been awarded \$100,000.00 in funding subject to the successful execution of Grant Agreement by all parties; and

WHEREAS, Corporation and HCR must execute a Grant Agreement, which is subject to Board approval in accordance with Corporation policies and by-laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LIVINGSTON COUNTY LAND BANK CORPORATION AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Executive Director of the Livingston County Land Bank Corporation is authorized to sign a Grant Agreement and any other documents related to the agreement with HCR, subject to the review and approval of the Corporation Board Attorney; and

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
