

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF LEGAL SERVICES: HURWITZ FINE PC

WHEREAS, the Livingston County Land Bank Corporation (the "Corporation") sought proposals for comprehensive legal services by Request for Proposals dated April 4, 2025, and 7 proposals were received; and

WHEREAS, a legal services committee was formed to conduct a comprehensive review of the submissions received and, as part of that review, the committee conducted interviews with three (3) firms; and

WHEREAS, the legal services committee has recommended Hurwitz Fine PC as the top choice for award; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation agrees with the recommendation of the legal services committee and seeks to award the contract for legal services to Hurwitz Fine PC; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance thereof, the Corporation and Hurwitz Fine PC must execute a fully-integrated agreement, which is subject to Board approval in accordance with Corporation policies and by-laws; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Livingston County Land Bank Corporation hereby awards the RFP for legal services to Hurwitz Fine PC; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a professional services contract with Hurwitz Fine PC as they are deemed the most qualified to provide the services. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
